We have the 'travelling bug'! Do you?


Some of us have travelled to different places around the world, for example:

#### Picnic Recipe: Chicken Pocket Pittas

Tired of always having the same food at the school picnic? Why not try making this easy, yet healthy snack.

#### **Ingredients**

- 1. a whole meal pitta bread
- 2. a chicken breast
- 3. a cucumber
- 4. a tomato







#### Steps

- 1. Cook the chicken breast in the oven, 250°C, for 20 minutes.
- 2. Wash the cucumber, tomato and lettuce.
- 3. Slice the tomato and the cucumber.
- 4. Mix the tomatoes, cucumbers and lettuce in a bowl.
- 5. Slice the chicken breast.
- 6. Cut open the pitta bread.
- 7. Put the tomatoes, cucumbers and lettuce in the pitta bread and eat it!
